


AROUND THE WORLD DEC' 25 - DEC' 26 Kids Space

APR' 26	JAPAN	Japan's appreciation for nature and simplicity shines during Hanami, the cherry blossom festival. its cultural philosophy embraces beauty in impermanence — seen in traditional arts like origami, tea ceremony, and woodblock printing that harmonize nature and design.
MAY'26	THAILAND	May in Thailand is a vibrant time to explore the country's festivals, traditional arts, and culinary culture. Colourful celebrations and craft traditions such as paper lanterns and intricate textile designs. Children can discover Thailand's rich visual culture through festival decorations, folk art, and the artistry of local crafts.
